## Christ's Ascension

Thursday last week was the official day of Ascension – coming as it did 40 days after Easter Sunday. That is the number of days, Luke tells us (in Acts), between Jesus' Resurrection and his Ascension into Heaven. Many churches now transfer this commemoration to the following Sunday. That is what we've done too because it would be a shame to miss the opportunity to reflect on and celebrate the mystery of Jesus' movement from this world to the next. At Christmas our focus is on the Word-made-flesh, that is, on the infinite, eternal and changeless God crossing over into our finite, temporal and ever-changing world in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. At Ascension our minds turn to what it might mean for us and creation now that our Lord has returned to the infinite realm not only as a soul or mind but as a body also. At the very least this signals a special bond between God the Creator, on the one hand, and the world that God created and declared to be very good, on the other. Christmas and Ascension signal to us something important about the nature of God that could (and has at times) been easily missed, which is that God loves the world, both the spiritual side of it and the material dimension—and is more than capable and comfortable bridging the gap between them.
