Christ is risen! He is risen, indeed, alleluia! This simple declaration and response is used today and throughout the services of the Easter season to remind us of the amazing, heartening and extraordinary fact that Jesus rose from his tomb on the first Easter Sunday. His body had lain there since the late afternoon of the preceding Friday, disturbed by no one—not even those loved ones who would usually anoint the body immediately after death—because the Sabbath was beginning and all work was forbidden. The women who came to tend Jesus' body as early as they could after the Sabbath were met by an empty tomb and, in Mark's account of that moment, 'a young man dressed in white,' who told them how they were to interpret the absence of Jesus' body; 'He has been raised; he is not here.' Wonderful news but very unexpected and, by all accounts, a little frightening. The resurrection of Christ has given hope to millions facing, as Jesus did, hardship, suffering and injustice. It is the victory of the power of life and love over death and hatred.
